2011 Total Look- STUDENT/ TEAM COMPETITION "Street Fashion Glamour"

COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

The "Total Look" is to be thought of with a "glamour" theme and it can be defined as "moderately formal". It should be in the Consumer Fashion category and should focus on street fashion. Glamour should signify an "evening" look which should suggest the versatility of hair as an art medium, being classic in form and shape, and imaginative in execution. The Competitor should use the hair, make-up, nails and wardrobe as a presentation of "street fashion glamour". The inspiration for this Competition is what is found today on the streets of New York, London, Paris and Milan.

The Competitor must provide an image of the "before look" of their Models- prior to any styling and/or make-up application.

A black/ white or color photograph will be accepted, and must be placed for the final Judging on the Competitor's table next to the Competitor's number. Slides or printed material will not be accepted. The categories for the final Judging consideration for both the male Model and the female Model are- Nails, Make-up, Hair (styling and cutting) and Wardrobe.

NAILS: The nail art of the Model is to be done on-site. Sages will view the nails prior to the start and at the completion of this segment.

There are 30 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. Nail extensions may be pre-applied before the Competition start.
2. The base shade of polish may be pre-applied before the Competition start.
3. Only evening, two- dimensional nail art should be applied during the Competition.
4. Toe nail art may be included in the final Judging.

MAKE-UP: The evening make-up for the female Model will be done prior to the hair styling segment.

There are 30 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. Model's skin should be prepared for make-up prior to the Competition start:
 - a. Pre-application of moisturizer and foundation is permitted.
 - b. Pre-application of any make-up or artificial lashes is not permitted.
2. A professional application for evening make-up should include the interpretation of the Competitor, enhancing the Model's appearance with cosmetic contouring (highlights and lowlights) and color.
3. Competitors will be judged on color enhancement, fashion effect, and overall presentation for the "Street Fashion Glamour" 2011 Total Look.

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HAIRSTYLING: The hair may be any length and may be dressed in an upward, downward, forward or backward direction, according to the Competitor's urging.

There are 45 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. Competitors will report with the female Model set and ready to comb out. The hair may be prepared in any manner deemed necessary by the Competitor. No pre-combing is allowed. All hair must be released, brushed and/ or combed during this segment.
2. The hair may be chemically prepared and cut prior to the Competition.
3. All finishing tools and products may be used on the Competition floor.
4. No wigs are allowed. Ornaments made from hair or other hair fibers are allowed- but they may not cover more than 25% of the head. They are not to be finished in advance. If the Sages wish to comb the ornamental hair through, prior to the start, they will be allowed to do so.
5. Hats may be worn by the Models, but remember, the Model's hair is one of the deciding factors in judging.
6. Decorative material may be used, however it must be within the artistic quality of the design.

HAIRCUTTING- Haircutting will be exercised on the male Model only. The male Model's make-up and nail finishing may be completed prior to the start of the Competition. The Model's cut should define his identity, his masculinity and his handsomeness.

There are 45 minutes allotted for this segment.

1. The male Model must be attired in Competition dress.
2. At least one inch (1") of the interior hair must be cut. This does not imply to the perimeter of the hair.
3. The Model's hair length shall be approved by the Sages before the cutting is to begin.
4. All finishing tools and products may be used on the Competition floor.

COMPETITION- GENERAL RULES

1. Each Competition Team may include one to four Team members (not including the two Models). In the event of 3 or fewer Teams> one overall award is given; 4-6 Teams> two overall awards are given and 7 or more Teams> three overall awards are given.
2. Competitions are open to all Students with less than 1250 hours with proof of enrollment in a licensed Barber/Beauty School or Apprentice Program with entry.
3. All Models and all Competitors must sign a - "PABCA Model Release Form". Models under 18 years of age must complete the "PABCA Parental Consent Form" along with the "PABCA Model Release Form".
4. Only the Team Members will be allowed to work on the Model. A different Team Member may work on different Competition segments during the allotted time. More than one Team Member may work on the Model at the same time.
4. The International 30 Point Scoring System will be used for judging. The Chairman of the Jury's scores will be used to break any ties. The Jury's decision is final!
5. The Competition Director and the Competition Committee shall determine any rule not herein provided for. The decision of the Committee is final!
6. Any Model used by an Educator of the PABCA, or in a manufacturer's booth on the day of the Competition, may not be used in the Competition.
7. The Competitor must sign and submit the official entry application and the required fee. In doing so, the Competitor agrees to abide by the Jury's decision- as final!
8. Entry fee refunds or credits may be issued, if approved by the Competition Chairman.
9. Any Competitor who arrives after the scheduled starting time may be disqualified, and entry fees may not be refunded. All Competitors and Models are advised to report to the registration area at least 30 minutes prior to the Competition's start.
10. It is each Competitor's responsibility to secure and furnish their own Models at their own expense as well as all tools and supplies needed.
11. Competitors may bring table lights, power strips and extension cords.
12. Any type of covering may be worn over the Model's wardrobe and may be removed before the final Judging.
13. All Competition work must be done on the Competition floor, unless otherwise specified.
14. No entry material will be returned and will become property of the PABCA.
15. Coaching by an Audience member for any Competitor results in a deduction of that Competitor's score by the Sages.
16. A 1,500 watt (or lower) blow dryer is recommended.
17. Once Models report for the Competition, they will not be released until the completion of the Judging, unless accompanied with a Sage.
18. When time is called, all Competition activity must stop, and neither Competitor nor Model will be permitted to spray or touch the finished product.
19. Award winning Competitors and Models must remain for photographs.
20. Water and energy drink is allowed on the Competition floor during the Competition.
21. All Judging is to be done at the completion of the final phase of the Competition.
